

Halloween half-term & Bonfire Night events we've helped to fund

Liverpool

FireFit Hub, Toxteth - £500, for events taking place during the Halloween and Bonfire Night period for young people. Activities include, basketball, football, table tennis, pool, gaming competitions, arts and crafts

Netherley Youth and Community Initiative - £250, for a disco and Halloween party for young people ages 8-19 years

Deysbrook Village Centre - £250, the centre will engage with 580 local residents per week who access various sessions, classes and services within the centre. The funding will be used towards aiding engaging activities with local young people in the area

An Hour for Others - £250, for their event that is running from 24th-28th October for children aged 8-13

Shrewsbury House Youth & Community Centre - £250, funding used for a pizza party and games for members, including an overnight sleepover for 60 young people

Young Persons Advisory Service, £250 – for activities including creative play, drama, dance and singing

Joseph Lappin Centre, £250 – a Halloween party which includes a disco, food and games with youths and families

Autism Adventures Training Ltd Community Interest Company, £500 – funding to provide a sensory space as well as food and a movie night

Norris Green Youth Centre Ltd - £350, funding for a three-day residential play away in Skipton, Yorkshire during half term

The Florence Institute Trust (The Florrie), £500 – daily workshops after school and in the early evening, featuring activities such as costume and mask making, Halloween window decorations, and decorations for the Grand Hall Halloween Party

Wirral

The Oldershaw School, CH45 4RJ - £500, for funding a Halloween disco. This will provide funding for a DJ, pizza, drinks, games, face painting and decorations

St Helens

Community Safety Team, St Helens Council - £1420, for the hire of a cinema screen at St Helens Cineworld for young people to enjoy a film

Knowsley

Centre 63, Kirkby - £250, for activities that will be delivered for 6 nights across October and November held at an organised event

New Hutte Neighbourhood Centre, Halewood - £250, funding will be used for movie nights, arts and crafts and multi-sports events for young people

Tower Hill Boxing club, Kirkby - £200, for a Halloween party aimed at young people between the ages of 7-15, the activity will include fun games and a DJ
